After-School Club Procedures

- Students are allowed to join only 1 club.
- Club fee must be turned in to the club teacher no later than the second meeting of the club.
- Club start time and dismissal time is different for each club. For more info see the club description.
- Dismissal location is the carline. Parents should park their cars and pick the children up from the dismissal station.
- Students must follow all school rules during the club time.
- Students should be picked up no later than the assigned pick-up time.
- Students who are picked up late more than twice will be removed permanently from extracurricular activities and the paid fee will not be refunded.
- Students will not be allowed to stay in the building unsupervised if they are not picked up on time. Any child that is not registered with Champions and is not picked up within 10 minutes of the club dismissal time, may be referred to Child Protective Service (CPS).

Description of the Club: In this hands on club, we will master several techniques used by professional French Pastry Chefs. Join the fun and learn the insider secrets of how professional chefs make those beautiful cakes you see in the windows of the bakery! We use styrofoam cake dummies, not real cake :)

Some of the things we will learn how to do:

- Sketch custom cake designs,
- Work with customers to create a dream cake
- Build a multi-tiered cake
- Color fondant
- Create beautiful sugar flowers
- Make figurines and cake toppers

We will start with the basics (understanding the tools, safety with the tools, importance of cleanliness, basic kneading and fondant care, etc.) Throughout the year we will build upon our skills, so it is important to (try your best) not to skip a week, as you may get a little behind. In addition, we will do projects that take a few weeks to finish. Before the end of the year, we will create a collaborative showpiece to display our newly acquired skills. This is a fun club that teaches real techniques. It is not an eating club :) This club will require lots of sharing of tools, patience and a level of maturity to maintain a safe environment. We will not use any nuts or nut products, however, we will be using gel food coloring to create different effects in the fondant.
